Welcome to the 13th Conference of AIDA which will be held at Akaki Tsereteli State University, Kutaisi, Georgia, **June 10-13, 2019**. AIDA (Association Internationale de Dialectologie Arabe), founded in 1993, in Paris, with the aim to encourage and promote the study of Arabic dialects, is nowadays the leading international association in this field of research and it has become a center that joins scholars from all over the world who are interested in any aspect of Arabic dialectology.

Fees

- Conference fee: €100 (the fees will include conference booklet, coffee break and lunch buffet)
- AIDA membership fee: €30.

Themes. Papers on all sub-fields of Arabic dialectology are welcome: dialects which have not been described yet, dialectal geography, specific aspects of phonology morphology and syntax, codeswitching, koine language, pidgin, creole, the lexicon of Arabic dialects, dialectal atlases, comparative and diachronic studies, sociolinguistics including studies on attitudes and ideology, teaching of Arabic dialects, literacy in Arabic dialects.

Paper presentation. Each participant shall deliver a 20-minute paper presentation, which will be followed by a 10-minute question and answer session. The conference halls will be equipped with basic audio-video equipment (such as projectors, projection screens, speaker and microphone systems).

Conference languages. The languages of the conference will be: Arabic, English and French.

Abstracts. Deadline for submission of the abstracts is November 30th, 2018. Selection and acceptation of the papers will be communicated by December 31th. 2018. Abstracts must be sent by e-mail (including author's name, complete affiliation and position) – as both .doc /.docx and .pdf documents to aida13kutaisi@gmail.com. If the paper has more than one author, when sending the

abstract, please include the names of all the authors, their complete affiliations and positions. **Papers must present original and innovative research**. The text of each abstract – written in Arabic, English or French and not exceeding 300 words – should clearly highlight the results of the research to be presented in the paper and their context. The abstracts of the accepted communications will be published in the abstract booklet of the conference.
